

# Volunteer to Serve in a MSHBA Leadership Position





## AB 450 – Commercial Building Code Effective Date Delay

The Wisconsin State Senate has approved AB 450, a bill that delays implementation of the commercial building code update to April 1, 2026. The measure passed 20–13, with all Republicans voting in favor along with Democratic Senators Kristin Dassler-Alpheim of Appleton and Brad Pfaff of Onalaska.

AB 450 previously cleared the State Assembly on a voice vote in October. The bill now heads to Governor Evers, who has not yet indicated whether he plans to sign or veto it. A coalition lobbyist recently met with a policy advisor in the governor's office and described the request to sign the bill as "a tough lift," though the advisor acknowledged the coalition's support as the governor considers his decision.

With strong Democratic support in the Assembly and two Democratic votes in the Senate, there is a credible opportunity to convince the governor to sign the bill.

However, the updated code technically went into effect on November 1, which presents an additional challenge for supporters.

#### AB 452 - Platting Process Reforms

AB 452, a bill incorporating several WBA-driven reforms to the platting process, continues to advance with strong bipartisan backing. Many of the changes included in AB 452 originated from a WBA subcommittee and are designed to streamline early stage development work and reduce delays.

Key provisions in the bill include:

- Allowing developers to meet informally with municipal representatives before submitting a preliminary plat to review subdivision concepts and applicable requirements.
- Permitting preliminary versions of sewer, water, road design, grading, stormwater, soil tests, landscaping, and street lighting to be used when seeking preliminary plat approval.
- Prohibiting municipalities from requiring installation of streets, sewer, water, and other improvements before approval, while allowing conditional approvals that require installation within a reasonable timeframe.
- Requiring municipalities—the approving authority—to issue final certifica-

tion within 10 days. Certification must also come from the surveyor and all parties with an interest in the property, with the municipal certification typically submitted last.

The State Senate passed AB 452 with an amendment last week on a voice vote, and the State Assembly approved the amended bill on Wednesday. With bipartisan support behind these common-sense updates, we are optimistic that Governor Evers will sign AB 452 into law before Christmas.

#### **Next Steps: Additional Priority Bills**

With several key victories this session, WBA advocacy now turns to securing State Senate floor votes on three additional priority bills:

- **AB 194:** Updates to WHEDA loan programs originally passed last session.
- AB 451: Authorizes creation of workforce housing TIF districts by municipalities.
- AB 453: The Truth in Planning proposal, requiring automatic rezoning of land designated for future housing when specific conditions are met after a developer applies for rezoning.

We are engaging key senators to help move these bills to the Senate floor. If you have relationships with your State Senator, please reach out and encourage support for passing AB 194, AB 451, and AB 453.
